The NRCS has become a universal tool for news broadcasters, and few journalists now have to worry about shuffling paper. But there is one area where the printed page is still very much part of the production process: the control room or gallery. Directors and other operational staff often work best from their own notes on paper copies of scripts, partly because those annotations have more meaning than electronic text, and partly because software often makes movement from one script to another relatively slow compared with flicking through printed pages. Traditional newsroom computer systems have failed to address those problems, yet the cost of printing, copying and distribution of paper scripts continues to rise.

- The software can run on a standard desktop PC, but will also operate on a Tablet PC (as illustrated). In this configuration, with wireless networking, the application becomes a virtual clipboard and can be used anywhere within the building.
- The user interface has been designed for fast, easy access. It displays two scripts side-by-side, and allows a rapid preview of items further down the running order. A single click, or button push, advances both the current and next items. A customizable toolbar provides quick access to other important functions.
